MINUTES OF CITY COUNCIL SPECIAL MEETING
April 23, 2012

Pursuant to due call and notice thereof, a Special Meeting of the City Council of the City of Nebraska City was conducted in the Council Chambers at City Hall, 1409 Central Avenue, on April 23, 2012. Notice of the meeting was given in advance thereof by email and telephone notification. Availability of the agenda was communicated in advance to the Mayor and Commissioners of this proceeding and said meeting was open to the public.

Mayor Hobbie called the meeting to order at 12:00 p.m. The Mayor publicly stated to all in attendance that a current copy of the Nebraska Open Meetings Act was available for review and indicated the location of such copy posted in the room where the meeting was being held. Mayor Jack Hobbie then led in the Pledge of Allegiance. Upon roll call the following answered present: Jeff Crunk, Dean Handy, Mark Mercer and Mayor Hobbie. Absent: Brett Gay. The following City Officials were present: City Administrator Joe Johnson, City Clerk-Treasurer Arnold M. Ehlers, and Public Properties Director/Zoning Director Dan Giittinger.

Mayor Hobbie introduced the agreement between the City of Nebraska City and Benesch & Co. for Preliminary Engineering and NEPA for the 4th Corso Viaduct removal and replacement project. Moved by Commissioner handy and seconded by Mercer to approve the agreement with Benesch & Co and authorize the Mayor to sign(Resolution 2563-12). Upon roll call the following voted YES: Crunk, Mercer, Handy and Mayor Hobbie. Voting NO: None. Motion passed.
