MINUTES OF CITY COUNCIL SPECIAL TWITTER TOWN HALL
September 13, 2018

Pursuant to due call and notice thereof, a Special City Council Twitter Town Hall of the City of Nebraska City was conducted in the William F. Davis Room at City Hall, 1409 Central Avenue and on online on the social media platform, Twitter at #NECityListens, on September 13, 2018. Notice of the meeting was given in advance thereof by posting in at least three public places, the designated method for giving notice, as shown by the Certificate of Posting Notice attached to these minutes. Availability of the agenda was communicated in advance to the media, Mayor and Commissioners of this proceeding and said meeting was open to the public.
