MINUTES OF CITY COUNCIL SPECIAL MEETING  
June 30, 2020

Pursuant to due call and notice thereof, a Special Meeting of the City Council of the City of Nebraska City was conducted in the Gary White Room at the ROWE Public Safety Building, 1518 Central Avenue, on June 30, 2020. Notice of the meeting was given in advance thereof by posting in at least three public places, the designated method for giving notice, as shown by the Certificate of Posting Notice attached to these minutes. Availability of the agenda was communicated in advance to the media, Mayor and Commissioners of this proceeding and said meeting was open to the public.

Vice President Gloria Glover called the meeting to order at 1:00 p.m. Vice President Glover publicly stated to all in attendance that a current copy of the Nebraska Open Meetings Act was available for review and indicated the location of such copy posted in the room where the meeting was being held. Vice President Glover then led in the Pledge of Allegiance. Upon roll call the following answered present: Paul Davis, Patrick Wehling, Vic Johns and Vice President Glover. Absent: Mayor Bequette. Mayor Bequette watched the proceedings via Zoom, but did not participate in the meeting or vote because the posted meeting notice did not provide the option to join via Zoom videoconference. The following City Officials were present: Interim City Administrator Marty Stovall, City Attorney Drew Graham, Utilities Director Jeff Kohrs and City Clerk-Treasurer Randy Dunster.

Commissioner Johns moved to approve minutes from the June 15, 2020 City Council Meeting with an amendment to adjust the minutes with regards to Resolution 2842-20 for the rework of the loan conditions. Motion seconded by Commissioner Wehling. Upon roll call the following voted YES: Davis, Wehling, Johns and Vice President Glover. Voting NO: None. Motion carried.

The City Council interviewed City Administrator candidate David Todd followed by a short break from 1:57pm to 2:13pm.

The City Council interviewed City Administrator candidate Matthew Rehder followed by a discussion of the remaining job candidate selection process.
