MINUTES OF CITY COUNCIL SPECIAL BUDGET MEETING
July 26, 2021

Pursuant to due call and notice thereof, a Special Budget Discussion Meeting of the City Council of the City of Nebraska City was conducted in the Gary White Memorial Room of the ROWE Safety Complex 1518 Central Ave, on July 26, 2021. Notice of the meeting was given in advance thereof by posting in at least three public places, the designated method for giving notice, as shown by the Certificate of Posting Notice attached to these minutes. Availability of the agenda was communicated in advance to the media, Mayor and Commissioners of this proceeding and said meeting was open to the public.

Mayor Bequette called the meeting to order at 8:30 A.M. The Mayor publicly stated to all in attendance that a current copy of the Nebraska Open Meetings Act was available for review and indicated the location of such copy posted in the room where the meeting was being held. Mayor Bryan Bequette then led in the Pledge of Allegiance. Upon roll call the following answered present: Patrick Wehling, Gloria Glover and Mayor Bequette. Absent: Paul Davis & Vic Johns. The following City Officials were present: City Administrator Lou Leone, Construction and Facility Manager Marty Stovall and City Clerk-Treasurer Randy Dunster.

Mayor Bequette announced that Commissioner Johns would be joining the meeting around 9:00 AM or 9:15 AM.

Moved by Commissioner Wehling and seconded by Glover to approve minutes from the July 19, 2021 City Council Meeting. Upon roll call, the following voted YES: Glover, Wehling and Mayor Bequette. Voting NO: None. Motion carried.

Commissioner Johns arrived at 8:55 AM.

The Council provided unanimous consent to make 3% the Cost Of Living Adjustment, (COLA), for all City employees for the FY21/22.

At 10:30 AM, a brief recess was announced, council resumed at 10:38 AM.

Moved by Mayor Bequette and seconded by Johns to fund the \$175,000 to SENDD and determine later in the budget process where to take the \$175,000 from and appoint Marty Stovall as the Primary Committee and Dan Mauk as the alternate. Upon roll call, the following voted YES: Glover, Wehling, Johns and Mayor Bequette. Voting NO: None. Motion carried.
