MINUTES OF CITY COUNCIL BUDGET PUBLIC HEARING

September 7, 2021

Pursuant to due call and notice thereof, a Regular Meeting of the City Council of the City of Nebraska City was conducted in the Gary White Memorial Room of the Rowe Safety Complex, 1518 Central Avenue and by video conference on the Zoom meeting platform, on September 7, 2021. Notice of the meeting was given in advance thereof by publication in the local paper and by posting in at least three public places, the designated method for giving notice, as shown by the Certificate of Posting Notice attached to these minutes. The agenda was made available via the City Website and communicated in advance to the media, Mayor and Commissioners of this proceeding and said meeting was open to the public.

Mayor Bryan Bequette called the meeting to order at 5:30 P.M. The Mayor publicly stated to all in attendance that a current copy of the Nebraska Open Meetings Act was available for review and indicated the location of such copy posted in the room where the meeting was being held. This meeting is also being recorded. Mayor Bequette then led in the Pledge of Allegiance. Upon roll call the following answered present: Paul Davis, Patrick Wehling, Gloria Glover and Mayor Bequette. Absent: Vic Johns. The following City Officials were present: City Administrator Lou Leone, Police Chief David Lacy, Fire Chief Rob Schreiner, Utilities Director Jeff Kohrs, Construction and Facility Manager Marty Stovall and City Clerk-Treasurer Randy Dunster.

Mayor Bequette opened the Public Hearing on the Budget for Fiscal Year 2021/2022. Lou Leone and Jeff Kohrs spoke to explain the budget. No comments were made by the public. Mayor Bequette moved to close the Public Hearing, seconded by Commissioner Glover. Upon roll call the following voted YES: Wehling, Glover, Davis and Mayor Bequette. Voting NO: None. Motion carried.
