MINUTES OF CITY COUNCIL SPECIAL MEETING
October 19, 2021

Pursuant to due call and notice thereof, a Special Meeting of the City Council of the City of Nebraska City was conducted in the Gary White Room at the ROWE Public Safety Building, 1518 Central Avenue, on October 19, 2021. Notice of the meeting was given in advance thereof by posting in at least three public places, the designated method for giving notice, as shown by the Certificate of Posting Notice attached to these minutes. Availability of the agenda was communicated in advance to the media, Mayor and Commissioners of this proceeding and said meeting was open to the public.

Mayor Bequette called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. Mayor Bequette publicly stated to all in attendance that a current copy of the Nebraska Open Meetings Act was available for review and indicated the location of such copy posted in the room where the meeting was being held. Mayor Bequette then led in the Pledge of Allegiance. Upon roll call the following answered present: Vic Johns, Gloria Glover and Mayor Bequette. Absent: Paul Davis and Patrick Wehling. Moved by Mayor Bequette and seconded by Johns to suspend the rules and switch items 2 and 3 on the agenda to interview candidate Tamra Walz first and Emily Beamis second. Upon roll call the following voted YES: Johns, Glover and Mayor Bequette. Voting NO: None. Motion carried.

The City Council interviewed City Attorney job candidate Tamra Walz.

The City Council interviewed City Attorney job candidate Emily Beamis.

Discussion/candidate review. Moved by Mayor Bequette and seconded by Johns to go into closed session to protect the reputation of our candidates, to be able to talk freely and that the closed session include the City Administrator. Upon roll call the following voted YES: Johns, Glover and Mayor Bequette. Voting NO: None. Motion carried. The Council began the closed session at 7:11 PM.

Council resumed Open Session at 7:59 PM. Mayor stated that direction has been given to the City Administrator.
