MINUTES OF SPECIAL CITY TOWN HALL MEETING  
March 31, 2022

Pursuant to due call and notice thereof, a Special City Town Hall Meeting of the City of Nebraska City was conducted in the Gary White Room at the ROWE Public Safety Building, 1518 Central Avenue, on March 31, 2022. Notice of the meeting was given in advance thereof by posting in at least three public places, the designated method for giving notice, as shown by the Certificate of Posting Notice attached to these minutes. Availability of the agenda was communicated in advance to the media, Mayor and Commissioners of this proceeding and said meeting was open to the public.

Vice President Gloria Glover called the meeting to order at 6:00 PM and excused Mayor Bequette's absence as he was out of town attending to a family matter. Vice President Glover publicly stated to all in attendance that a current copy of the Nebraska Open Meetings Act was available for review and indicated the location of such copy posted in the room where the meeting was being held. Vice President Glover then led in the Pledge of Allegiance. Upon roll call the following answered present: Ron Osovski, Patrick Wehling and Vice President Glover. Absent: Mayor Bequette and Vic Johns. The following City Officials were present: City Administrator Lou Leone, Utilities Director Jeff Kohrs, Construction and Facility Manager Marty Stovall and City Clerk-Treasurer Randy Dunster.

Moved by Commissioner Osovski and seconded by Wehling to approve minutes from the March 21, 2022 City Council Meeting. Upon roll call, the following voted YES: Wehling, Osovski and Vice President Glover. Voting NO: None. Motion carried.

Vice President Glover presented the discussion regarding American Rescue Plan Act, (ARPA) Funds and Lou Leone facilitated the discussion.
