INVITATION TO BID**

Sealed Proposals for the construction of “**2021 11th Street Trail – North Table Creek Bridge to Athletic Complexes for Nebraska City, Nebraska,**” JEO Project No. **190156.00**, QuestCDN No. **8344538**, will be received by the City Clerk at **1409 Central Avenue, Nebraska City, NE 68410**, until 10:00 AM on the 26th day of November, 2024, and thereafter will be read aloud.

The work is generally described as follows: Construct approximately 3,450 linear feet of 10’ wide and 5” thick concrete trail. Other improvements consist of installation of RCP culverts and flared end sections, steel sheet piling and pedestrian handrail installation, trail signage and pedestrian crossing improvements, seeding and erosion control measures.

Opinion of Probable Cost \$563,000.00

Proposals will be taken for said construction work listed above by unit prices, as an aggregate bid for the entire project.

All Proposals for said construction work must be made on blanks furnished by the Engineer and must be accompanied by Bid Security of not less than 5% of the amount bid. Bid Security to be made payable to the Treasurer of the City of Nebraska City as liquidated damages in case the bid is accepted and the bidder neglects or refuses, to enter into contract and furnish bond in accordance herewith.
